COUNTY OF MARION

This contract and agreement is entered into under authority of V.T.C.A., Government Code 323.011, and is to be effective as of the 1st day of January, 2025 by and between Marion County, Texas a political subdivision of Texas, hereinafter called COUNTY and the Jefferson Library and Museum Association, a Texas non-profit corporation, with offices in Marion County, Texas acting herein by its Director, Peter Kuchta, hereinafter referred to as LIBRARY, whereby the parties' contract agree to the following:

WITNESSETH:

- I. This contract and agreement shall remain in full force and effect for a period of ONE (1) YEAR, beginning on the I" day of January, 2025, unless sooner terminated as provided for by V.I.C.A. Government Code 323.011.
- 1 The LIBRARY, being an established library, agrees to assume the function of a free library for the County of Marion, Texas, and to furnish library service to all citizens of said county without charge under identical conditions.
- 3. The COUNTY agrees to designate the LIBRARY as the public agent of the COUNTY for the purpose of providing services to the residents of said county. The LIBRARY is thereby empowered to adopt policies and procedures for the use of the public library by the residents of said county.
- 4. In consideration for such services mentioned above, the COUNTY agrees to budget each year an be based upon a budget submitted to the COUNTY by the LIBRARY in accordance with requirements set the COUNTY.
- 5. It is agreed that this contract may be renewed and extended at the termination of same for an additional period of time upon terms and conditions to be agreed upon by the parties hereto.
- 6. It is further agreed that this contract may be terminated at any time by either party by giving written notice of such intentions six (6) months in advance of such termination.
- 7. All personal property, including books, furniture, equipment, files, and any and all other personal property acquired under the terms of this contract shall always be the personal property of the LIBRARY.

- 8. The LIBRARY agrees to provide the COUNTY with an annual audit of the financial accounts of the LIBRARY, showing both income and expenditures, and shall make available to the COUNTY any other reports of the financial condition of the LIBRARY as may be required by the COUNTY. County funds should be specifically identified in the annual audit.
- 9. It is agreed and understood by and between the contracting parties that all expenses, bills, and accounts incurred in the operation, maintenance, purchasing, and all accounts incident to the LIBRARY, shall be paid by the LIBRARY, and the COUNTY shall not be held liable for any debts of the LIBRARY.
- 10. The COUNTY shall not be held liable to the LIBRARY or to the LIBRARY's employees, patrons, or visitors, for any damage to person or property that might arise at the public library facility, and the LIBRARY agrees to hold the COUNTY blameless from any and all claims arising at such premises.
- 11. The LIBRARY agrees to furnish the COUNTY with an annual report of the performance and effectiveness of the LIBRARY in providing library services to the residents of Jefferson, Texas. Such report will be due at the close of the city's fiscal year.
- 12. The LIBRARY retains the right to negotiate with other governmental bodies to provide library service and to receive sums for the same.

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF MARION AND THE CITY OF JEFFERSON COVERING SHARED SERVICES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

THE STATE OF TEXAS

THE COUNTY OF MARION

WHEREAS, Marion County has recently completed an addition to its jail facility; and

WHEREAS, Marion County has entered into an agreement with the East Texas Council of Governments to assist is securing 911 services; and

WHEREAS, Marion County provides financial support to all volunteer fire departments in the county, including the Jefferson Volunteer Fire Department (\$14,000 for 2025); and

WHEREAS, The City of Jefferson has an existing need for prisoner housing, Police dispatch services and Courtroom facilities; and

WHEREAS, The City of Jefferson provides extensive financial support for the Jefferson Volunteer Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of both entities to provide for the continued provision of all of these services to their mutual citizens and taxpayers in a mutually beneficial arrangement and both entities desire to contractually agree as to terms and conditions by which those services may be provided in the most efficient and economical manner possible;

NOW, THEREFORE, Marion County and the City of Jefferson, each acting herein by and through their duly authorized chief elected official, after due consideration and approval of this contract by the Commissioners Court of Marion County and the City Council of the City of Jefferson, do hereby covenant, stipulate and agree by and between them as follows:

1. Marion County will accept prisoners of the City of Jefferson Police Department without charge to the City of Jefferson, unless set out below. Once accepted, those prisoners shall be under the full control of the Sheriff of Marion County and shall be subject to all rules and regulations of the Marion County Jail and Sheriffs Department. The County will be under no obligations to accept prisoners who require special medical or mental treatment or under circumstances which would cause the Marion County Jail to exceed the number of prisoners allowed in that facility by the Texas Commission on Jail Standards. The City of Jefferson shall be directly responsible for any and all medical care rendered to any prisoner subject to the Class C Misdemeanor Jurisdiction of the City Court and accepted by Marion County under this agreement. Further, the City of Jefferson shall be directly responsible for any and all medical care, including any associated transport, rendered to any city prisoner through the time of arraignment. Prisoners delivered to the Marion County Jail by officers of the City of Jefferson

who are subject to the jurisdiction of any Justice Court, County Court or District Court shall be the responsibility of Marion County. The City of Jefferson, as a part of this agreement and based upon the consideration extended by Marion County, agrees to indemnify and hold harmless, Marion County, its agents, employees and elected officials, against any and all claims arising or to arise out of any action of any such prisoner of the City of Jefferson, acting alone or in concert with another prisoner. Such indemnity shall include, but not be limited to, attorney's fees, damages, judgment, fees, and expenses, court costs, investigation fees, and out of pocket expenses. Marion County reserves the right to, if named as a defendant in any litigation arising out of any action by a prisoner of the City of Jefferson, to retain counsel of its choosing whose fees and expenses shall be directly paid by the City of Jefferson as a part of such indemnification.

- 2. Marion County will dispatch the officers of the City of Jefferson Police Department as needed each week day and every weekend. Marion County assumes no responsibility for the actions of any officer so dispatched and such officer shall not be considered an agent of the County or the Sheriff of Marion County.
- 3. Marion County will provide 911 emergency dispatch services to the City of Jefferson beginning on the same date that the service becomes available to those residents of the county residing outside the limits of the City of Jefferson.
- 4. The City of Jefferson will provide financial support annually for costs incurred by the Marion County Sheriff's Office for dispatch/jailer services. The amount of financial support shall be \$1,000. per month, \$12,000. per annul. This amount shall be reviewed annually at the execution of this agreement.
- 5. Marion County will allow the City of Jefferson to use the District Courtroom or Alternate Courtroom between the hours of 8 AM until 5 PM during normal business days, provided the courtrooms are not in use by the District Judges, or Marion County.
- 6. Marion County will provide financial support annually to the City of Jefferson for the support of the Jefferson Volunteer Fire Department. The amount of financial support shall be determined annually by the Commissioners Court of Marion County during its annual budget process and shall be an amount equal to that amount set aside in that budget for Marion County Precinct #2 and allocated by the duly elected Commissioner of that precinct.
- 7. The City of Jefferson will provide financial support to the Jefferson Volunteer Fire Department as needed to maintain the service.
- 8. The City of Jefferson will provide the fire protection services of the Jefferson Volunteer Fire Department to residents residing outside the limits of the City of Jefferson to the extent that the resources are, at the time of need, available. No distinction shall be made in the dispatch of fire protection services outside the limits of the City of Jefferson and all resources, including equipment and personnel not then in use shall be available to respond to those calls.

8. This Agreement will expire on December 31, 2025.

This Agreement and the terms set forth above constitute the entire agreement regarding these matters between Marion County and the City of Jefferson and all prior negotiations, discussions and understandings have been merged herein and made a part hereof. There are no oral agreements or understandings which survive the execution of this written agreement.



RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF MARION COUNTY, TEXAS IN SUPPORT OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CIVIL COURT ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION SYSTEM

WHEREAS, a county dispute resolution fund maintained in the county treasury, as required by Tex. Loc. Gov't Code § 135.151, may be used by a county only to establish and maintain an alternative dispute resolution system in accordance with Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code Ch. 152; and

WHEREAS, an alternative dispute resolution system is "an informal forum in which mediation, conciliation, or arbitration is used to resolve disputes" as defined in Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code§ 152.001, and will be an invaluable tool for resolving disputes among our citizens and will free up our local courts' civil dockets; and

WHEREAS, in Texas, approximately 75%-80% of cases that go through ADR settle. These are resolved with fewer costs to both the litigants and the court, in much less time than going through the court system and with a mutually agreeable solution; and

WHEREAS, the county's dispute resolution fund may continue to assess fees and retain such fees for the research, development, and ultimate operation of the county's established alternative dispute resolution system under Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code Ch. 152, without remitting such fees to the State; and

WHEREAS, county commissioners by order may establish an alternative dispute resolution system as authorized by Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code§ 152.002;

WHEREAS, the Marion County Commissioners Court desires to support and establish such an alternative dispute resolution system for the benefit and enhancement of the civil court system.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the Marion County Commissioners Court does hereby establish an alternative dispute resolution system under Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code Ch. 152, and as specifically authorized by Tex. Loc. Gov't Code Sec. 135.151, all civil case filing fees, collected from all new district, county, and justice court case filings and allocated to the dispute resolution fund, shall remain with the county for the research, development, and ultimate operation of the county's alternative dispute resolution system.
