APPLICATION/ PERMIT TO INSTALL ENTRY CULVERT IN COUNTY ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY DITCH LINE

THE STATE OF TEXAS

Now on this ____ day of _____, 20__ came on to be considered the application of _____ for a permit to install an entry culvert in the ditch line of _____ in Marion County, Pct. ____.

Pursuant to the Texas Transportation Code §251.003, 251.016, 254.006, and Texas Health and Safety Code §121.003, it is therefore ordered that the following policies are adopted:

- 1) There will be a \$300.00 charge for a culvert installation;
- 2) A property owner creating a new entry into property from a county maintained public road, must make application to the Commissioner's Office for a permit authorizing such work or installation. Permits are free of charge;
- 3) It is required that the property owner or contractor contact the Marion County Commissioner of that precinct to receive determination on appropriate culvert diameter size and length adequate to allow for necessary water flow and safe entry.
- 4) Marion County will only provide one (1) culvert per installation. It is the property owner responsibility to mark where the new culvert is to be installed and the property owner will be responsible to call Texas 811 Call before you Dig to have utilities marked where new culvert is to be installed;

- 5) The property owner shall be responsible for purchase of culvert and pick up or delivery costs. The property owner shall call the County Commissioners Office to schedule culvert installation when culvert is on site and utilities have been marked.
- 6) The Commissioner will install culvert at earliest convenience. This scheduling does not take priority over county road repair that is impacting the traveling public;
- 7) If scheduling for install is not satisfactory, the property owner may install driveway culvert at their own expense to county specifications and responsibility to call 811 is on property owner and contractor.
- 8) After new installation, the property owner shall be responsible for any necessary maintenance and repairs. If property has an existing culvert, the County will not install another. Existing culverts will only be replaced if damaged.

The Marion County Commissioners Court does APPROVE/ DENY the application to install a culvert at designated location and such culvert and installation shall be to the specifications authorized by this permit.

Culvert shall be marked with proper markers in a clear and visible manner on each end of said culvert.
