RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF APEXUM HEALTH SYSTEMS AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF A RURAL HOSPITAL FACILITY IN JEFFERSON, MARION COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the Marion County Commissioners Court, is committed to promoting the health, safety, and welfare of their residents and to fostering economic development within the region; and

WHEREAS, Marion County and the surrounding East Texas region have experienced significant challenges in healthcare access, with residents often traveling considerable distances to obtain essential medical services, emergency care, and specialty treatments; and

WHEREAS, the lack of local hospital services has created hardships for our aging population, working families, veterans, and vulnerable community members who deserve quality healthcare close to home; and

WHEREAS, Apexum Health Systems has proposed the development of a rural hospital facility in Jefferson, Texas, utilizing an innovative integrated healthcare delivery model combining brick-and-mortar facilities, virtual care capabilities, and mobile health services; and

WHEREAS, the proposed hospital project is expected to create significant employment opportunities, stimulate economic growth, and attract ancillary businesses and services to the Jefferson and Marion County area; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Commissioners Court of Marion County, Texas, that:

SECTION 1. The Marion County Commissioners Court hereby express their full and unequivocal support for Apexum Health Systems and the proposed rural hospital project to be developed in Jefferson, Marion County, Texas.


SECTION 2. The Marion County Commissioners Court recognizes the critical importance of this project to the health, welfare, and economic vitality of our community and the broader East Texas region.
