
WHEREAS, on the 30th day of March, 2026, the Commissioners Court of Marion County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Commissioners Court of Marion County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the San Jacinto Day period beginning April 16, 2026 and ending at midnight April 21, 2026, subject to the following restrictions:

- a. This order expires on the date the Texas A&M Forest Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, April 21, 2026, whichever is earlier.


