

Application Filing and Authorized Representative Resolution

A RESOLUTION by the Commissioners Court of the Marion County requesting financial assistance from the Texas Water Development Board; authorizing the filing of an application for assistance; and making certain findings in connection therewith.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Commissioner Court OF THE Marion County:

SECTION 1: That an application is hereby approved and authorized to be filed with the Texas Water Development Board seeking financial assistance in an amount not to exceed \$ 10,000,000.00 to provide for the costs of water and sewer water infrastructure improvements throughout the county.

SECTION 2: That the County Judge, Leward J LeFleur be and is hereby designated the authorized representative of the Marion County for purposes of furnishing such information and executing such documents as may be required in connection with the preparation and filing of such application for financial assistance and the rules of the Texas Water Development Board.




